## Annual Tenant Holiday Party








Watt Plaza has 2 - 3 yard bins in front of the compactor to capture the buildings wet waste from the first floor retail / food tenants. While these bins are not weighed, industry standard for this kind of waste is 125 lbs per cubic yard which is 750 lbs per pickup. Watt Plaza has 1 - 30 yard compactor that captures all of the office waste and recycling from the 2 buildings. There is a source separated recycling program in place for the office tenants and all recyclables are collected in blue bags while the wet waste is collected in clear bags. The compactor is taken to the La Puente Hills MRF where approximately 90% of the compactor loads are successfully diverted from the landfill for recycling
